To You with Whom I am yoked in Christ,

I trust this will find you well as you labor in the Lord's vineyard.

This is a brief update of how my life has been since I left USA on January 30th.

In the month of January while I was in USA, together with you, we were watching Kenya as it burned with many homes being set on fire whereby, many people lost their properties, over 1,000 people killed and over 300,000 were displaced. Many of these people are still in camps undergoing much suffering and with many kids not attending schools. Since February, I have visited many of these camps only to leave there depressed as I come in touch with an agonizing people, men, women and children. I have also, quite a number of times been covered by the media calling for quick resettlement of these people by the government but unfortunately, the people in the government are so busy working on the power sharing between the two parties who had previously engaged in antagonism which caused the unrest in Kenya and causing so much pain. There are calls from different churches and organizations, calling for the government to debate as a matter of urgency on the resettlement of the victims of the conflict but this has not become an issue since the two parties are concerned on how much their tribes will get the parliament powers. It is tribal scramble for positions. Please, pray that, these victims of tribal conflict will become an agenda for the government. There is so much suffering which will even become more chaotic with the coming of the rains. Kenya gets her long rains beginning April.

As you might be aware, the warring parties got somehow reconciled by the Koffi Annan Mediation Team and now the struggle is on the sharing of the power. As they do this, there is allot of suspicion and manipulation from each side and only time will tell how things will end. For me, the time for celebration is not yet. Allot of water will have to pass under the bridge.

Taking the role of Gideon to bring the healing of the nation, I have embarked on fighting the spiritual warfare over the nation. The name of this group is Msafara (convoy). With 300 people (in six buses and small cars) and composed of church leaders from different churches and many intercessors, we started visiting the main cities and towns in Kenya and more so, the towns where there were more deaths and displacement. We started on March 7th. In each of these towns, we are spending two days. The first day is spent with the church leaders, talking about reconciliation and healing among them, for if the church has to act as a catalyst for the national reconciliation, then this cannot take place without church leaders being in one accord. This is more so because, during the time of election and with the unrest, church leaders had taken sides on tribal bases, some even participating in the organization of the mayhem. Our church has one who left the parish and organized how the churches were to be burned in that parish including the manse.

The second day in our Msafara is held on open ground, for example in a stadium, where hundreds of people gather for the prayers of repentance. We have witnessed many people shedding allot of tears both in the church leaders' meetings and the general population. In the Msafara, different people from different tribes pray in repentance on behalf of their tribes.

As I write, we are at Kisumu which is at the shores of Lake Victoria. This is where much destruction of businesses was done and also many people from the Kikuyu tribe were killed. We arrived here yesterday after two days of spiritual warfare in Eldoret where hundreds of Kikuyu tribe had their property either looted, burned, flocks of animals like cows taken away, and thousands of people killed. Here in Kisumu, we spent the whole morning with the church leaders and in the afternoon, we held an open forum for the Word and prayers of repentance. Tomorrow (Sunday) we will visit churches and in the afternoon, we will hold an open forum in the Kenyatta Sports Stadium where thousands are expected to turn up. This is proving to be the healing catalyst for the nation. This mandate on the church bringing healing in the nation is mandated by

God as spelt out in 2Chronicles 7;14, "If the people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face...then I will hear from Heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land". This is why I have taken this mission aggressively. We have so far waged spiritual warfare over six main towns (cities) including Mombasa and Nairobi, in a way of cleansing the land, paving ways for the reconciliation and repentance for sins committed at the times of campaigns and the times of unrest. We are also praying (with some people fasting) because of the times ahead for we know that the devil would hate any peace to come. We are praying that God would open channels of peace so that this nation which would be strategically well placed in the world would be saved from the devil's tricks of destruction. In doing this, we are also taking time to visit the people in the camps around the place we are waging spiritual warfare. This is greatly touching these tribal clashes victims, some of whom have started doubting the presence of God in their lives. Our visit is encouraging many of them. Please, keep on remembering these people in your prayers. Keep on praying as well for me. There are thousands of people in Kenya who think I have the answer for both the physical and spiritual survival of Kenya. I sometimes feel myself so inadequate in many ways, but I am trying to use any opportunity that God brings on the way. A message I have received as I write this says, "I am praying for you so that you may assist the nation to know the truth and repent..." Another one says, " I am excited to hear what God is doing there (Kisumu) through you. May his presence mightily be with you and the blood of Jesus be your protection and shield and may his purpose be established".

It is important to understand that, some of the places we are visiting as nationally known to be the very strongholds of the devil. This is more so with places like Kisumu and Mombasa. The well known witchdoctors and water spirits are found here. Witchcraft thrives in these places. This is where most of the politicians go and pay millions to acquire the high level of demonic powers. I need allot of covering as I am so involved with national issues on an everyday basis. My book, EXPOSING AND CONQUERING SATANIC FORCES OVER KENYA, and of which I have released a second edition has undergone allot of coverage by the media and it has caused a stir among many of the politicians. This edition has come up with added materials with more ungodly symbols which are found in many GOVERNMENT buildings. This second edition is written and is much bigger volume. The parliament opened on March 8th and many members of parliament were not comfortable with my prayers that I offered in its opening as one part of the prayers, I challenged the satanic powers that caused oppression to the life of the nation. In praying this way, I am aware that more than 80% of the members of parliament are depending on witchcraft and other satanic powers. This they know and so does the public.

Finally colleagues, May the Grace of God be with you all.
